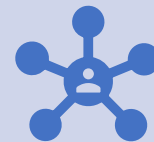

Student Responsibilities

Recognize that your college classes are different from your high school courses.

Keep up with reading assignments, tests, syllabus, and course expectations.

Students, advocate for yourself and speak with your professors before you feel like you are struggling.

Check emails frequently. Professors will communicate through UTRGV email.

Actively participate in class through discussion boards and assignments and take notes to identify the important points.

Guiding principle: College is a learning environment in which students take responsibility for thinking through and applying what they have learned

- Dual Credit student expectations are the same as other UTRGV students:
 - Attendance
 - Self-Advocacy
 - Attempted hours do factor into Federal Financial Aid assistance (180 max hours)
- There are consequences to failing:
 - Academic Probation; Suspension
 - Damaged GPA will follow the student throughout their entire college career and future professional career
 - Unable to return to UTRGV or to another university
 - May impact future financial aid.

 - Puede tener dificultad para poder regresar a la universidad

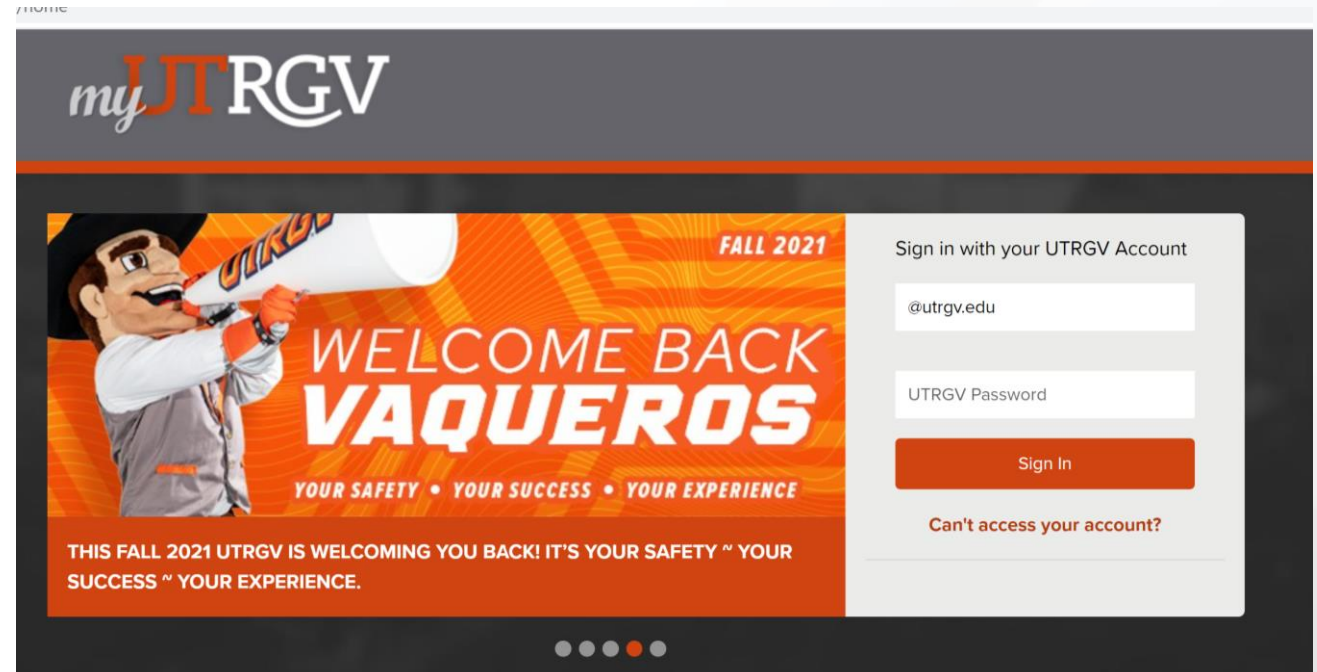
